

Master's Certificate in Public Sector Management

The Master's Certificate in Public Sector Management (MCPSM) is an executive education program designed to expand and equip the competencies of professionals who are employed within the public sector. All courses are designed and taught by subject experts who provide thought provoking and innovative perspectives and will encourage best-practices in communication, leadership and management strategies that are relevant to government or public organizations.

Participants will explore strategic topics during 15 days (September to April) with other public sector leaders who share similar challenges within a safe environment. Relevant guests and controversial topics will also encourage opinions, discussion and will prepare you to be confident and informed leaders. Successful completion will be awarded a framed certificate and recognition to their employers.

Application Process:

Participants may apply or be referred to the program who are employed by a public organization and must currently in a supervisory or management position or those who have been targeted for a promotion.
