# **CHAIR'S REPORT**

Board Chair Peter Williams noted that UOIT is notable among CCOU member universities in having a custom governance course for its governors. The course will be delivered by Rotman's School of Business in December. He also noted that there will be a strategic planning retreat in February.

#### PRESIDENT'S REPORT

President McTiernan indicated that 17 faculty had been granted tenure, and that this was a reflection of their high quality and level of service.

He had had the privilege of attending DC's fall convocation the preceding week and it was an outstanding reflection of education as a community as well as an individual activity.

President McTiernan and MaryLynn West-Moynes, VP External Relations, represented UOIT at the Ontario Economic Summit. The focus of the Summit was on transformation, healthcare delivery and the role of energy in Ontario. The need for collaboration was a recurring theme throughout the Summit, reflected in President Clinton's remarks as well as the focus of MTCU Minister Glen Murray.

President McTiernan further reported that UOIT has been immersed in the strategic planning process and consultations with internal as well as external stakeholders.

## **UOIT ACADEMIC OVERVIEWS**

Provost Richard Marceau introduced the university's academic leadership team to the board of governors. He indicated that the 2012-13 Viewbooks containing detailed overviews of each academic area had been distributed at the university fair and were provided to each governor. He then introduced each member of the Provost's Council. The members of the Provost's direct reports (i.e., Nawal Ammar, Dean Social Sciences and Humanities; George Breznai, Dean Energy Systems and Nuclear Science and Dean Engineering and Applied Science; Brian Campbell, Associate Provost Graduate Studies; Victoria Choy, Registrar; Bill Muirhead, Associate Provost Academic; Michael Owen, Associate Provost Research; Deborah Saucier, Dean of Science; Brad MacIsaac, Assistant Provost, Planning and Analysis; and Olivia Petrie, Academic Counsel Secretary) each gave a short overview of their career before arriving at UOIT, and a brief introduction to their faculty and/or area of responsibility.

Board Vice-Chair Larry Seeley congratulated the Provost and his academic leadership team on behalf of the entire board, and thanked them for their very impressive and informative remarks.

# STRATEGIC PLANNING PROCESS

Brad MacIsaac, Assistant Provost, Planning and Analysis gave a powerpoint presentation on the strategic planning consultation steps and a status report on the consultation results to date. The board accepted the report as presented.
