Pay Statement Examples – Hourly Paid Employees

Beginning in January 2019, the university is changing the way the pay rate is reflected on the pay statement for employees with limited term hourly employment contracts.

Example 1: Administrative Staff employee with a limited term hourly employment contract working 25 hours per week and earning \$22.79 (equivalent to job level 3, step 3 on the Administrative Salary Grid).

Existing employment contract: \$22.79 per hour
