2. Smart Commute Durham presentation

- Angie and Sandra from Smart Commute to introduce the vision of Smart Commute
 Durham (SCD) to committee. SCD is run by Metrolinx. Introduced concept of
 Transportation Demand Management (TDM) Plans and focus on taking vehicles off
 the road. Goal to reduce Monday-Friday traffic by working with workplaces in
 Durham Region.
- Currently work on promoting and marketing carpooling but now they are moving to customize the approach.
- UOIT could be a great host for these initiatives. The goal is to keep students using transit after graduation.
- After conducting the survey, 800+ responses of UOIT students received (10% of the population). Travel behavior of students: most walk and use public transit. Home origin of students spread out, students commute from far locations. 378 use transit.
- 160 driving alone, but 103 are interested in car sharing (in the existence of blancride)





- UOIT has a great opportunity to be involved in TDM program. Educating the students is the key, especially with Blancride.
- Public transit should be better used as well, TDM is crucial for sustainability because it is a long term solution.
- Suggestion to better promote carpooling and carpooling services on campus.
- Send out the survey to staff as well, also tracking for carbon footprint. Total staff of 1623. Ensure distance and commute time is part of the survey
- Student that won the SCD survey received her prize. All info will be passed on to communications and marketing to compile a news piece.
