**REASON FOR CHANGE AND WAYS IN WHICH IT MAINTAINS/ENHANCES COURSE OBJECTIVES**

This winter semester course builds on Foundations I held in the fall of first year. As its name implies, is foundational to the praxis of nursing students. It provides practicum preparation through laboratory and class sessions. The course is currently pass-fail/non-credit. However, students must be successful in this course to proceed to clinical practice in the following semester.

The Collaborative students are required to take PSYC 1000 Introductory Psychology and we recommend that the second required psychology course, PSYC 2010 Developmental Psychology, be an elective for Collaborative BScN students. PSYC 2010 Developmental Psychology would remain a required course for the RPN to BScN students who do not take Introductory Psychology.

The proposed change is to change a required Developmental Psychology course into an elective for Collaborative BScN students. It would remain a required course for the RPN to BScN students. The 3.0 credit freed for Collaborative BScN Students would be applied to Foundations II. The course would then be graded and part of the student's GPA.

Dean Livingston consulted with Dean Ammar who agreed to this change in status for Developmental Psychology. We believe that many Collaborative BScN students will take Developmental Psychology as an elective.
