

## **Amendments to Graduate Academic Calendar due to name change**

As a result of the recently approved change in name from Office of Graduate Studies to School of Graduate and Postdoctoral Studies, there are amendments required to regulations in the Graduate Academic Calendar to reflect the new name. We are requesting that the GSC approve, in principle, all changes in wording in the Graduate Academic Regulations from “Office of Graduate Studies” to “School of Graduate and Postdoctoral Studies”. No change in the name of the unit will affect the purpose or purview of the regulation. Specific Graduate Academic Calendar references affected include:
