Review of Candidate Eligibility	Tuesday, March 13 to Friday, March 16
Student Candidate Information Meetings (mandatory)	Monday, March 19 & Tuesday, March 20
Campaign Period (if required)	Monday, March 26 – Wednesday, April 4
Voting Period (if required)	Wednesday, April 4 until Friday, April 6
Voting Results Presented to ACX for Recommendation (or earlier in writing)	Tuesday, May 1 (pending any outstanding investigations per Election Procedures)
ACX's Recommendation Reported to Candidates	Wednesday, May 2
ACX's Recommendations presented to Academic Council for Approval	Tuesday, May 15
