Proposal Brief

Summary of the proposed change

Addition of CRMN 4001 Special Topics in Criminology and Justice as an alternative option for 4th year required courses in the program map. It will be added to the [One of: CRMN 4099U – Criminology and Justice Integrating Project or SSCI 4102U – Honours Thesis II] grouping of courses. This grouping will now read: [One of: CRMN 4099U – Criminology and Justice Integrating Project or SSCI 4102U – Honours Thesis II or CRMN 4001 Special Topics in Criminology and Justice].

All Criminology and Justice program maps (Major, Major with Specialization(s), Bridge, Advanced Entry) will reflect this change to the 4th year curriculum.

Description of the ways in which the proposed change will enhance the program and/or opportunities for students

The proposed change will allow 4th year students another course option for which to choose from, that satisfies the requirement of an advanced writing course. Currently, CRMN 4099 Criminology and Justice Integrating Project is the only course that reflects this requirement. The proposed CRMN 4001 Special Topics in Criminology and Justice will require students to satisfy the same advance writing requirements through the submission of a final paper, but will afford students the opportunity to also delve into significant depth a particular topic in criminology, according to the course instructors' research interests and specialization.
