SUBJECT: Nominations – Academic Appeals & Honorary Degrees Committees

COMMITTEE MANDATE:

Section III (5) of the ACX Terms of Reference provides that one of the responsibilities of ACX is to present nominations for all standing committees of Academic Council to Academic Council for approval.
