CPRC approved the Minor Program Adjustment in accordance with its mandate under Section 3, Part B:2 of the Institutional Quality Assurance Process (Quality Assurance Handbook).

CPRC is providing this report to Academic Council for information.

BACKGROUND/CONTEXT & RATIONALE:

The Faculty wishes to add INFR 4450U to the program in the choice of electives, remove INFR 4800U as a core and list it instead as an elective, and remove CSCI 4100U as an elective choice, being replaced by the new INFR 4450U course. The number of core courses drops from 5 to 4 and the electives increase from 1 to 2. These changes will provide students with more course options allow the Faculty to schedule INFR 4450U and INFR 4800U in alternating years depending on availability of professors and student interest.
