SUBJECT: Minor Program Adjustment – MSc and PhD – Applied Bioscience	

COMMITTEE MANDATE:

In accordance with Section III, part d) of the Graduate Studies Committee (GSC) Terms of Reference, GSC has the responsibility "to approve minor program adjustments" and report them to Academic Council for information.

BACKGROUND/CONTEXT & RATIONALE:

The Faculty proposed adding APBS 6800G - Geographic Information Systems (GIS) & Spatial Analysis to the list of approved of elective courses. This course was approved in 2019-2020 but wasn't added to the list of electives in the program information section at that time. The addition of APBS 6800G to the list of approved electives provides students with more options in meeting the elective requirements of the program.

RESOURCES REQUIRED:

There are no financial or resource implications as this course is already included in the rotation of APBS elective courses, and is offered as needed based on Graduate students' area of study.
