### COMMITTEE MANDATE:

In accordance with Section 1. b) of the Undergraduate Studies Committee (USC) Terms of Reference, USC has the responsibility “to approve minor program adjustments and report them to Academic Council for information.”

### BACKGROUND/CONTEXT & RATIONALE:

The Faculty proposed to adjust the program map for students entering this program from Durham College, due to changes made to the qualifying programs only at DC.

### TRANSITION PLAN:

Students entering the program from Durham College prior to Fall 2022 will remain on their original program map. Students entering the program from Durham College in Fall 2022 and onwards will be on the new map.
