COMMITTEE MANDATE:

In accordance with Section 1. b) of the Undergraduate Studies Committee (USC) Terms of Reference, USC has the responsibility "to approve minor program adjustments and report them to Academic Council for information."

BACKGROUND/CONTEXT & RATIONALE:

The Faculty proposed to clarify the wording in the Calendar regarding 'promotion' vs. 'progression'. The Calendar entry is used by students while they are in the program. 'Promotion' implies that requirements are applicable at specific points of advancement (e.g., moving from year 1 to year 2), while 'progression' provides flexibility to address the ongoing checks and balances within the program (i.e., submission of appropriate required documentation to enter practicum; completion of course work in order to enter practicum, etc.).
