SUBJECT: Academic Council 2023 Supplementary Election Process

COMMITTEE MANDATE:

- Section 1(b) of the GNC Terms of Reference provides that GNC is responsible for overseeing the process of recruitment, selection, and election of new members of Academic Council (AC) and its committees and recommending appointments for approval by AC in accordance with the university's Act and By-laws
- A summary of remaining upcoming vacancies for the elected positions on AC and its committees, and a timeline for a second round of elections, was presented to GNC for approval

BACKGROUND/CONTEXT:

- The 2023 Academic Council Election took place from February 13 – March 17 in accordance with the Election Timeline that was approved by the committee in January 2023
- There were several vacant positions on Academic Council and its standing committees for which no nominations were received
- At the Committee meeting in March 2023, GNC directed the University Secretariat to run an additional round of elections to begin after the end of the Winter 2023 term with a timeline that would allow successful candidates to be approved at the June 2023 meeting of Academic Council

NEXT STEPS:

The results of the second round of nominations will be presented to GNC and Academic Council in June 2023.
