COMMITTEE MANDATE:

In accordance with the Undergraduate Studies Committee (USC) Terms of Reference, USC has the responsibility "to examine proposals for new undergraduate degree programs and major changes to existing programs and to recommend their approval, as appropriate, to the Academic Council".

MOTION FOR CONSIDERATION:

That pursuant to the recommendation of the Undergraduate Studies Committee, Academic Council hereby approves the Major Program Modification to the BA and BSc Psychology program to add a new specialization in Cognitive and Brain Sciences.

BACKGROUND/CONTEXT & RATIONALE:

The Faculty is proposing to:

- Add a specialization in Cognitive and Brain Sciences to the BA and BSc in Psychology program.
- Create two new courses:
 - PSYC 3510U Research Methods in Neuroscience
 - o PSYC 3520U Introduction to Cognitive Neuroscience

The Psychology BA and BSc have been in effect since Fall 2020. The programs have grown to include a minor and now three specializations.

Student feedback on the two existing specializations have been positive. We are building local expertise in cognitive and brain sciences that we can leverage. These are tech-forward disciplines that will align with university goals and attract a different type of student than other psychology streams.

Students who complete a specialization in *Cognitive and Brain Sciences* will receive targeted education pertaining to neural mechanisms and the cognitive processes that these mechanisms engender. Topics may include neural communication, neural function and dysfunction, neural systems, research methods in neuroscience, thinking, reasoning, attention and decision making.

New specialization and courses will be available to students beginning Fall 2024.
