1. CHAIR'S REMARKS

5. PROVOST'S REMARKS

Dr. Marceau noted several items for information:

- Colleagues were thanked for their patience and graciousness at the picket lines during the recent labour dispute at Durham College.
- Colleagues were also thanked for their support and participation in the homecoming event that was held over the past weekend, which was a great success.

- Enrolments at UOIT have increased by 10% over the previous year, 11% at the undergraduate level and 3% at the graduate level. Again, colleagues were thanked for continuing to make UOIT an institution of choice for new students.
- Dr. Deborah Saucier, the new Dean of Science was welcomed to Council.
- An announcement was recently circulated concerning the appointment of Dr. Tarlochan Sidhu as the next Dean of Engineering and Applied Science. He will begin his term on January 1, 2012.
- Due to the recent departure of the interim Chief Financial Officer, the budget update will not be provided to Academic Council at this meeting as planned, but will be added to the agenda of the October meeting.

5.1 Development of the Next UOIT Strategic Plan 2011-2016

Dr. Marceau reviewed the process and timelines for the development of the next UOIT strategic plan. He noted that the plan will be developed in two phases. The first phase will involve information-gathering and analysis of the goals and expectations of colleagues and students that will lead to the identification of strategic institutional priorities. The second phase will involve the development of draft unit plans which will further inform the institutional plan and be subject to another round of review by the campus community. A complete and comprehensive institutional strategic plan with supporting documentation will be submitted to the President in May 2012.
