Removal of DIGITAL FORENSICS Specialization

Faculty of Science, University of Ontario Institute of Technology Apr. 10, 2012

Rationale: The Digital Forensics specialization was designed as a complement to the other Forensic programs in the Faculty of Science (Forensic Science, Forensic Physics). Unfortunately, a lack of faculty resources and low enrollment in this area makes it difficult to offer this specialization. We propose removing the specialization and focusing our efforts on our two areas of strength — Computing Science (comprehensive) and Digital Media (specialization). This shift in focus directly reflects the strategic plan of Computing Science and the Faculty of Science.

Analysis of the enrolment implications: This specialization has attracted 0-2 students per year and there will be minimal enrolment implications to the Computing Science program by removing Digital Forensics. In fact, we believe that removing Digital Forensics and focusing on our comprehensive Computing Science program and Digital Media specialization will allow us to attract more students into those programs.
