Program closures can also be initiated by the Provost in cases where the program is deemed no longer viable due to academic weakness, declining enrolment, financial exigency, if the program has not been offered for two years, or if a Program has not been reviewed in accordance with the Institutional Quality Assurance Policy.

Proposed:

Program closures can also be initiated by the Provost due to issues related to substandard academic quality as determined through a number of different assessments such as cyclical program review, Key performance Indicators, self-examination, financial exigency, admission pause for over two years and/or a Program has not been reviewed in accordance with the Institutional Quality Assurance Policy.
