SUBJECT: Minor Program Adjustment – Bachelor of Commerce Major in Organizational Behaviour and Human Resources Management

COMMITTEE MANDATE:

In accordance with Section 1. b) of the Undergraduate Studies Committee (USC) Terms of Reference, USC has the responsibility "to approve minor program adjustments and report them to Academic Council for information."

BACKGROUND/CONTEXT & RATIONALE:

The Faculty is adding BUSI 4330, Managing Team Dynamics to the list of Organizational Behaviour and Human Resources Management (OBHR) Electives. Managing team dynamics is inherently a part of the broader scope of organizational behavior and this course is an appropriate fit for the OBHR major program. Including this elective gives students more choice in their electives; it also gives students the opportunity to take a course that will provide skills directly related to their major.

RESOURCES REQUIRED:

There are no financial impacts as this course is already offered as a business elective. The number of students in the course will likely increase, but it will not affect program enrolment.

TRANSITION PLAN:

Retroactively permit OBHR majors in 2nd, 3rd, and 4th year to include BUSI 4330U as a major elective; all new majors will be permitted to take the course as a major elective.
