Date: August 27, 2019

In an effort to increase the quality of Ontario Tech University's undergraduate international applicant pool the Office of the Registrar is proposing an admission based partnership with Language Studies International.

This partnership would allow for international students who have successfully completed Language Studies International Advanced level with a passing grade of 84% on the exit test to be evaluated for admission to Ontario Tech University undergraduate programs that require a 6.5 IELTS on a competitive basis without the presentation of a standardized English language test (TOEFL, MELAB, CAEL etc.)

For programs that require a 7.0 IELTS (Nursing and Education), students who graduated from Language Studies International Advanced level with a passing grade of 84% on the exit test, can opt to enroll at Ontario Tech University ECL's Level 6 or submit an IELTS of 7.0. Upon completion of ELC Level 6, students will be evaluated for admission to Ontario Tech University undergraduate programs that require a 7.0 IELTS on a competitive basis without the presentation of a standardized English language test (TOEFL, MELAB, CAEL etc.)

LSI levels have been closely matched to the Common European framework, TOEFL iBT, TOEIC, IELTS and University of Cambridge English examinations. To move up to the next LSI level students need to master their specific 'level objectives', which students can demonstrate by test scores and class participation.

They only provide one-to-one tutoring in an online format. All of the classes are taught in person at their locations.
