### COMMITTEE MANDATE:

In accordance with the Undergraduate Studies Committee (USC) Terms of Reference, USC has the responsibility “to approve minor program adjustments and report them to Academic Council for information.”

### BACKGROUND/CONTEXT & RATIONALE:

The Faculty is proposing a number of small adjustments to the Calendar entry for the program. A list of Technology Management electives will be included and INFR 1100U and INFR 2140U are replaced with INFR 1101U and INFR 2141U, respectively. Additionally, an error in the number of required courses is being corrected and the program description is updated. These changes provide clarity and aligns the program with others in the Faculty.

### RESOURCES REQUIRED:

With fewer elective courses required it is anticipated that the Faculty will save resources.

### TRANSITION PLAN:

All Technology Management students will follow this updated program. Students who have taken INFR 1100U or INFR 2140U will be able to proceed in the program as if they had taken INFR 1101U or INFR 2141U.
