SUBJECT:	Minor Program Adjustment – Master of Science and Doctor of Philosophy in Computer Science

COMMITTEE MANDATE:

In accordance with Section 3, Part B-2 of the University's Institutional Quality Assurance Process (Quality Assurance Handbook), "Minor adjustments to programs and regulations must be presented directly to the Graduate Studies Committee (GSC)...for consideration following their approval by Faculty Council. The committee will conduct a quality review of the program proposal using the UOIT Program Quality

Review Criteria...Any changes must receive this committee's approval prior to their implementation and inclusion in the academic calendars. The outcomes of the review are subsequently reported to Academic Council for information."

BACKGROUND/CONTEXT & RATIONALE:

The Faculty is adding CSCI 5770G to the Information Science area course list. Many students who enter the program have little or no prior machine learning experience. This course will develop students' understanding in fundamental topics, and then move to discussing the more advanced, recently published, topics. The idea is that a deeper understanding of the material will enable students to not only 1) apply existing machine learning tools to problems at hand, but also 2) add to the machine learning body of knowledge.
