1. Bachelor of Arts in Adult Education and Digital Technology—Name Change and Major Program Modification

The Curriculum and Program Review Committee recommends:

That Academic Council approve the name change from Bachelor of Arts in Adult Education and Digital Technology to Bachelor of Arts in Educational Studies and Digital Technology and the creation of two specializations within the program (Adult Education and Digital Technology and Early Childhood Studies).

The Faculty of Education has put forward a proposal for major program modifications to an existing program, the current BA in Adult Education and Digital Technology (BA AEDT). The Faculty is proposing to rename the program to the Bachelor of Arts in Educational Studies and Digital Technology (BA ESDT) and offer two specializations: Adult Education and Digital Technology, and Early Childhood Studies in order to broaden the array of program options available to undergraduate students. The overall learning outcomes for the program remain the same and only four new courses are required. The detailed proposal is attached as Appendix A.
