1. Call to Order

The Chair called the meeting to order at 2:30 p.m. M. Serote read aloud the land acknowledgement.

2. Agenda

5. Chair's Remarks

With respect to the latter, a discussion ensued about compliance in response to committee comments and questions. The Chair expressed concern about non-compliance reported in some areas of campus and agreed to look into the matter. The Provost added to the varsity sports discussion by advising the Committee that the Ontario University Athletics curling finals will be hosted here in Oshawa on the weekend of February 3-5, 2023.

7. Nominations

(a) Open Positions and Elections Key Dates

The University Secretary provided an overview of the positions for which elections will be held in the spring on Academic Council and certain of its Committees. In response to a question, the University Secretary confirmed that the timelines mirror those followed for past elections. A discussion then ensued on ways to best disseminate elections information to those who might be interested in running, as well as those eligible to vote. The Committee expressed support of the timelines, particularly as they are harmonious with having vacant committee positions filled for the fall. It was recommended to the University Secretary that nomination forms or other elections communications materials make clear that Academic Council is a prerequisite of service on certain committees.
