Assignment Chunking

Breaking assignments into **smaller, more manageable chunks**—like a to-do list—can help you stay on task. Planning your time this way considers breaks to manage disability-related impacts to your studies.

Recommended steps:

- 1. Create a template with three different headings:
 - **Coursework**
 - **Stages**
 - **Tasks**
- 2. Write in your **coursework** (e.g. essay, lab).
- 3. Identify the different **stages** (e.g. draft, edit, submit) needed to complete the entirety of the work and estimate how long each stage will take you (e.g. 2 to 3 days).
- 4. Brainstorm and add in small, manageable **tasks** for each stage (e.g. find two articles, read one chapter).
- 5. Focus on one **stage** at a time. Try to complete all **tasks** within the time you’ve given yourself.
- 6. Reflect on whether you’ve given yourself enough time and adjust your following timelines as needed.

Test taking tips

Before the test



- Prepare ahead of time.
- Bring everything you need.
- Arrive early and sit somewhere you feel the most comfortable.
- Take a few deep breaths and relax—you've got this!

When you receive the test



- Read through the entire thing and estimate how much time you think you'll need to spend on each question.
- Pace yourself based on the number of points questions are worth.
- Do a brain dump for 1 to 2 minutes. Unload any information, equations or other information you have in your head so you don't forget later.

Answering test questions



- Read each question and the instructions thoroughly.
- Circle key words and—if you need to—rephrase questions to make them into statements.
- Answer **all parts** of the question.

If/when you get stuck



- Mark that question to return to and move onto the next one.
- Think back to when you were studying—can you recall anything related to that topic? Look for clues in other test questions.
- Think about all the ways you engaged with the material over the course of the semester (e.g. visuals, auditory cues, examples, etc.).
- Consider the question from the professor's point of view—what knowledge do you think they want you to demonstrate?

Conclusion



- Develop a system for going through the test to ensure you don't miss any questions; answer everything!
- Leave time to double-check your answers.
- Triple-check any questions and answers you had trouble with.
