
What You Will Need



You can only store 100 MB of files in Canvas. If you've

Canvas, click on Account (top left), then Files. • **DO NOT** delete files for assignments that have not been graded yet.

- **DO NOT** delete files for other quizzes or exams from this semester.
- Use a good file-naming system so you can remember which pictures are being used.

ONLY delete files that are not currently in use.

I can't email my photos Check the file size. Try <u>compressing</u> or <u>zipping</u> the images.

My images won't upload to the dropbox or question entry box Make sure you create your file in a compatible program. Check your Internet connection.

HEIC files will give an error. See Step 2 in this document. If you are unable to upload (you get an error), check your file storage in Step 5.
