NEW BUSINESS

2008-09 Graduate Tuition Fees

President Bordessa reported that a review has been conducted of the process for setting graduate and international tuition fees. He further noted that UOIT would like to make the necessary adjustments to align these fees with that of other universities as UOIT's graduate and international tuition fees were much higher than the system average, resulting in difficulty in attracting graduate students to this institution.

Gerry Warman joined the meeting at this time.

It was reported that the university's plan is to freeze existing graduate and international tuition rates. It was reported that although UOIT will still remain above the average, as other universities implement their increases UOIT will quickly fall into line with those universities.

In response to a question relating to laptop provisions for graduate students, Provost Richard Marceau confirmed that there is concern amongst UOIT faculty regarding the absence of a laptop program at the graduate level. He reported that UOIT is attempting to resolve this issue by allowing students to bring their own laptop on campus.
