General Major Courses and Electives

Explanation of Electives

BUSI Elective: For example – BUSI 1700U – Introduction to Entrepreneurship or BUSI 2000U – Collaborative Leadership. General Commerce students require a minimum of ten BUSI electives.

General Elective: A course outside of business. For example – PSYC 1000U – Introduction to Psychology or SCIE 1920U – Introduction to Astronomy. General Commerce students require a minimum of three general elective courses.

Open Elective: Can be either a BUSI or general elective.
