

About Career Chats:


The concept of Career Chats is to allow the student to meet in a safe environment with an employer (usually someone in a recruitment role) one on one where they can ask the employer anything about employment, the job search, the recruitment process etc. Career Chats is not about looking for a specific job at the host company although, sometimes students may ask a question or two. But the main purpose is to have someone from the working world answer their career-related questions. This is done on Google Meets with the students one on one. We host this event on the last Tuesday and Thursday of every month from 2:00 pm to 4:00 pm.

- 1. Do you mind looking at my resume and giving me a few pointers?
- 2. Can you have a quick glance at my LinkedIn?
- 3. I have never been able to answer the weakness question in an interview, how would you suggest I approach that?
- 4. How important are having questions to ask the employer at the end of the interview?
