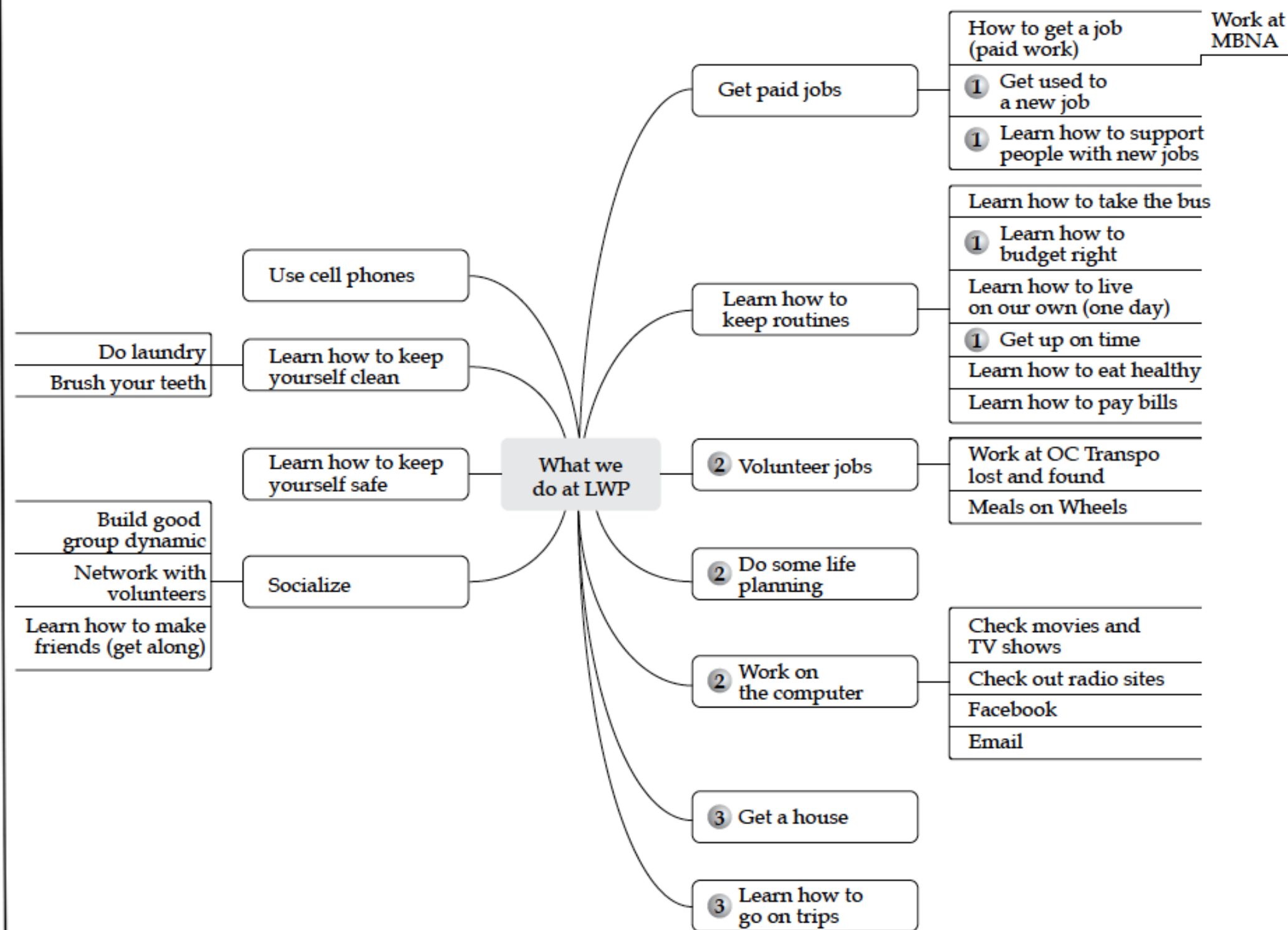
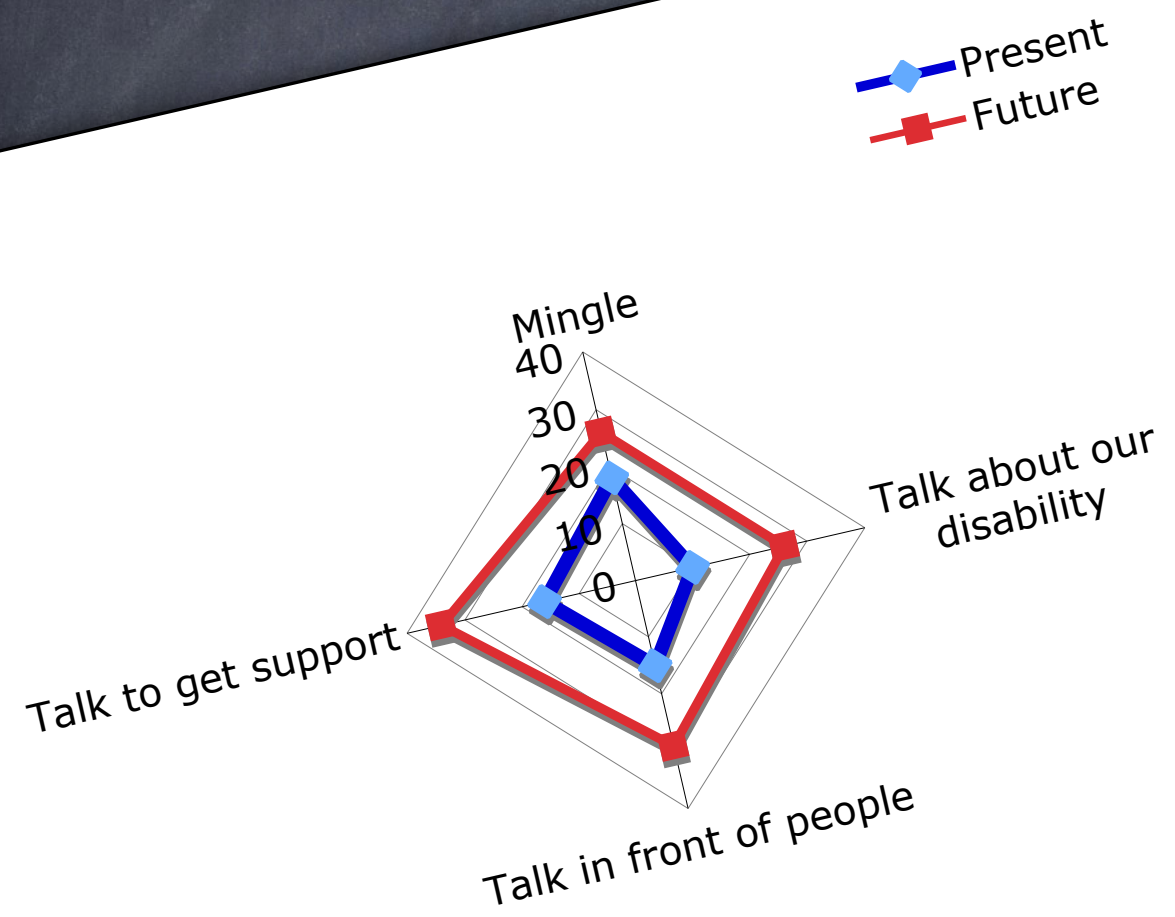
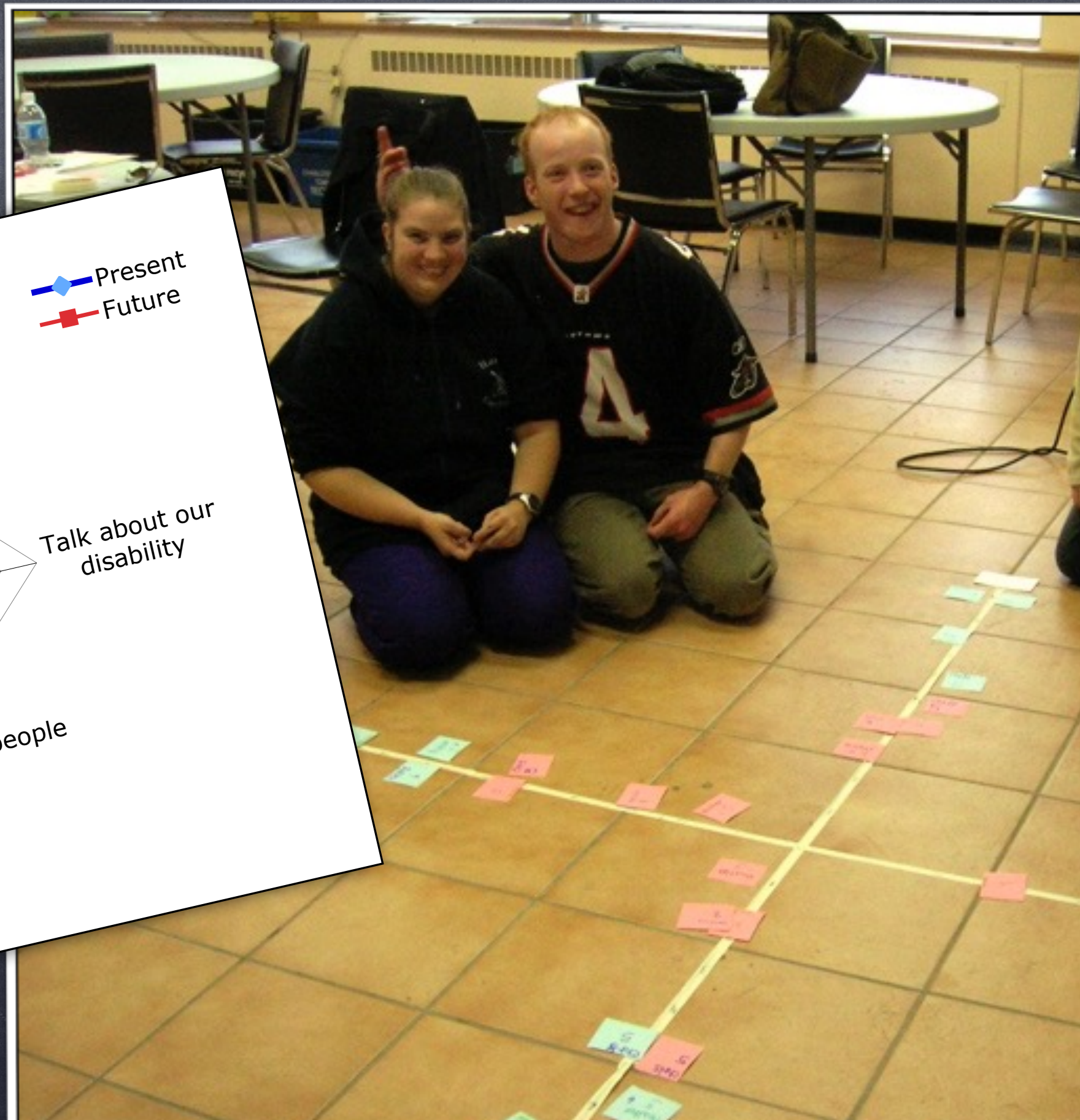
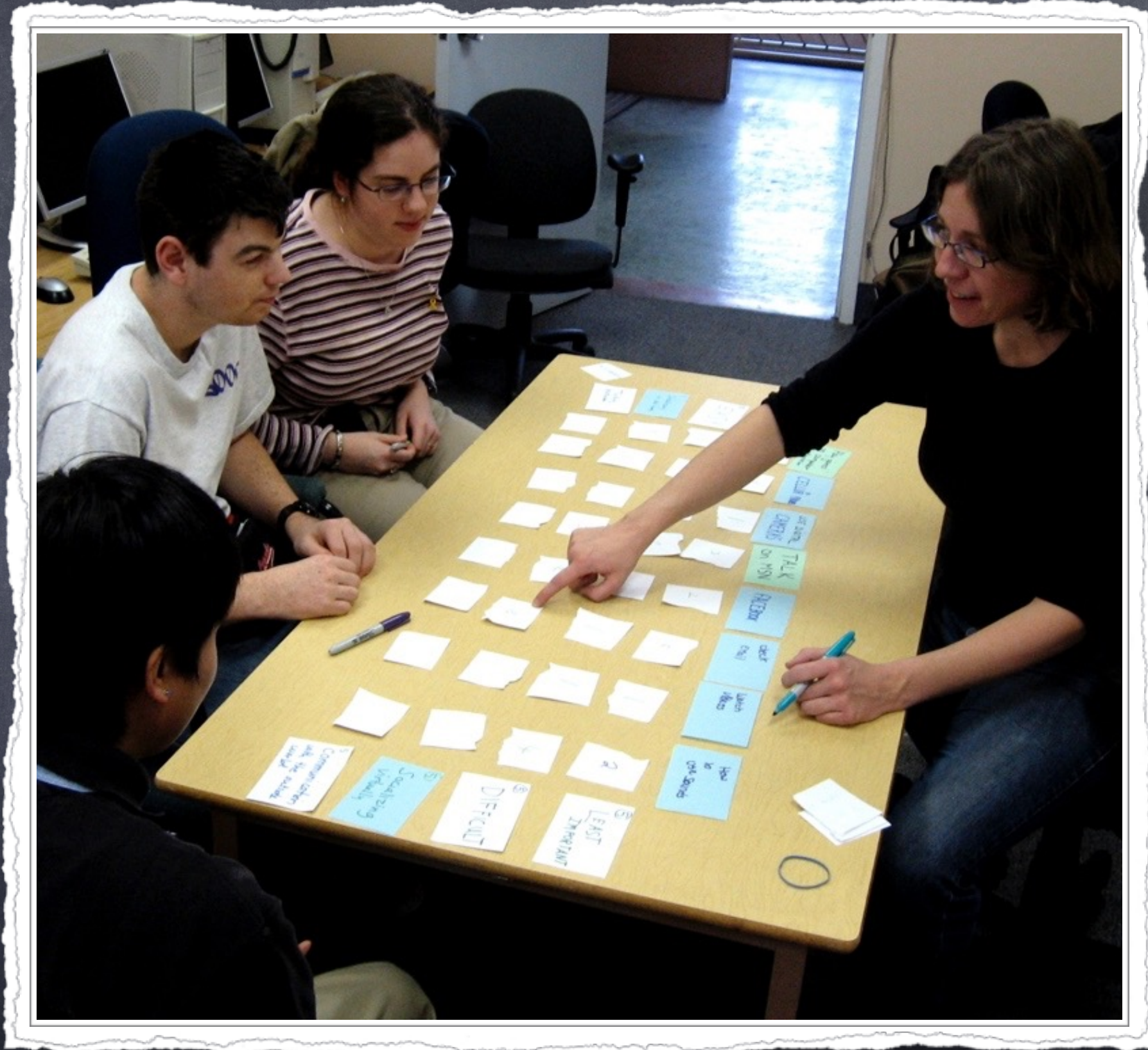


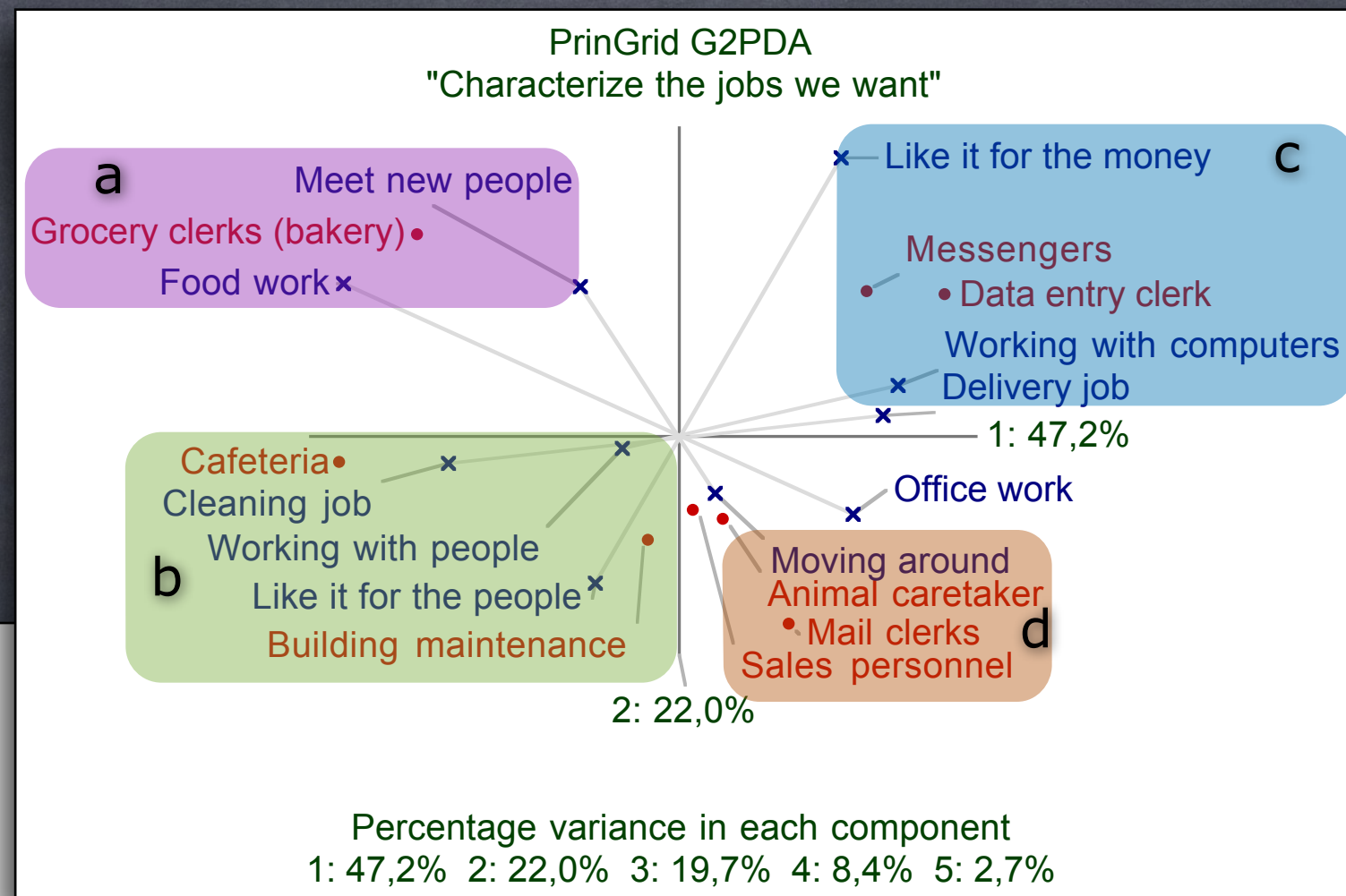
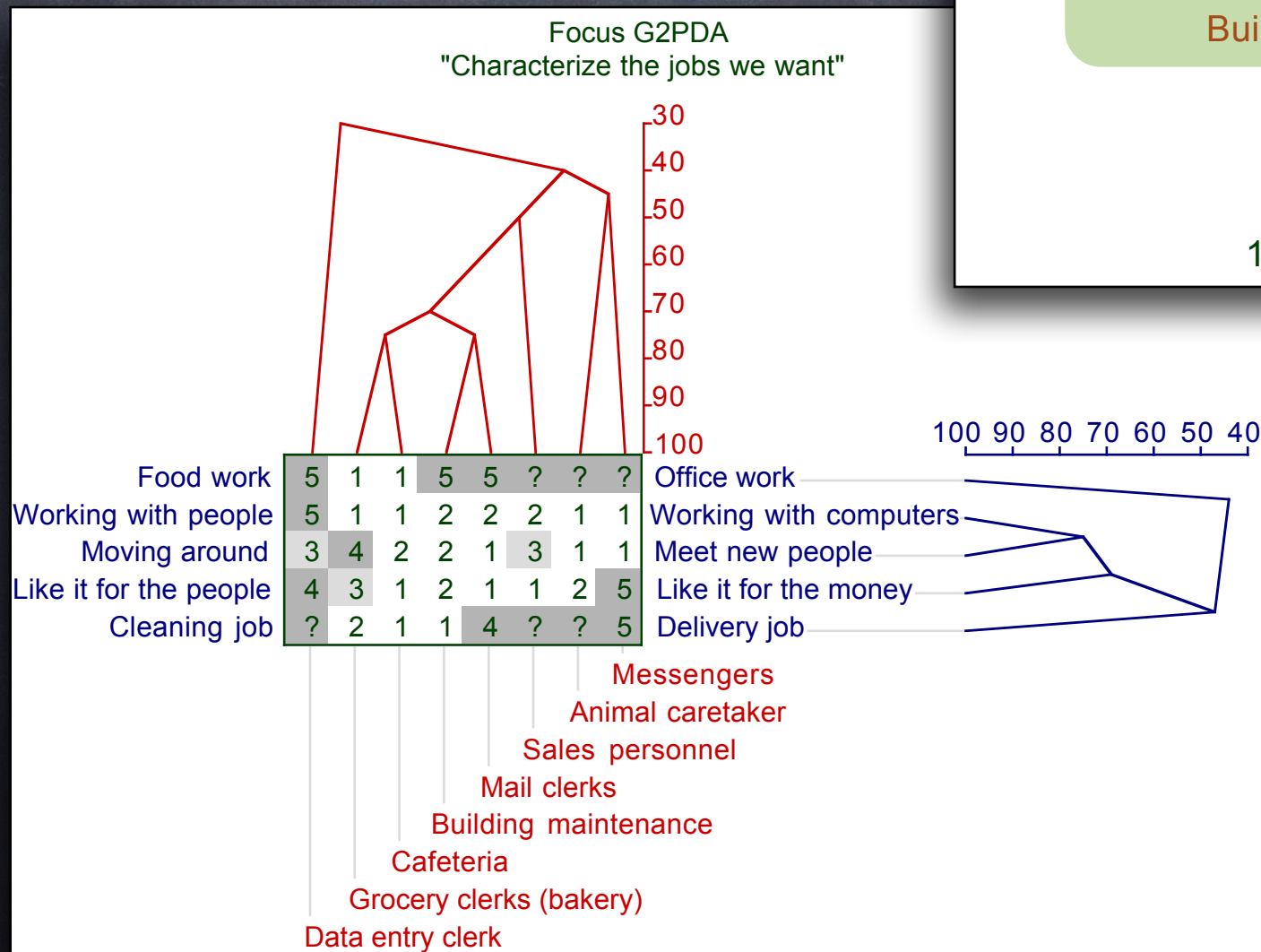
Figure 1. Activity Map

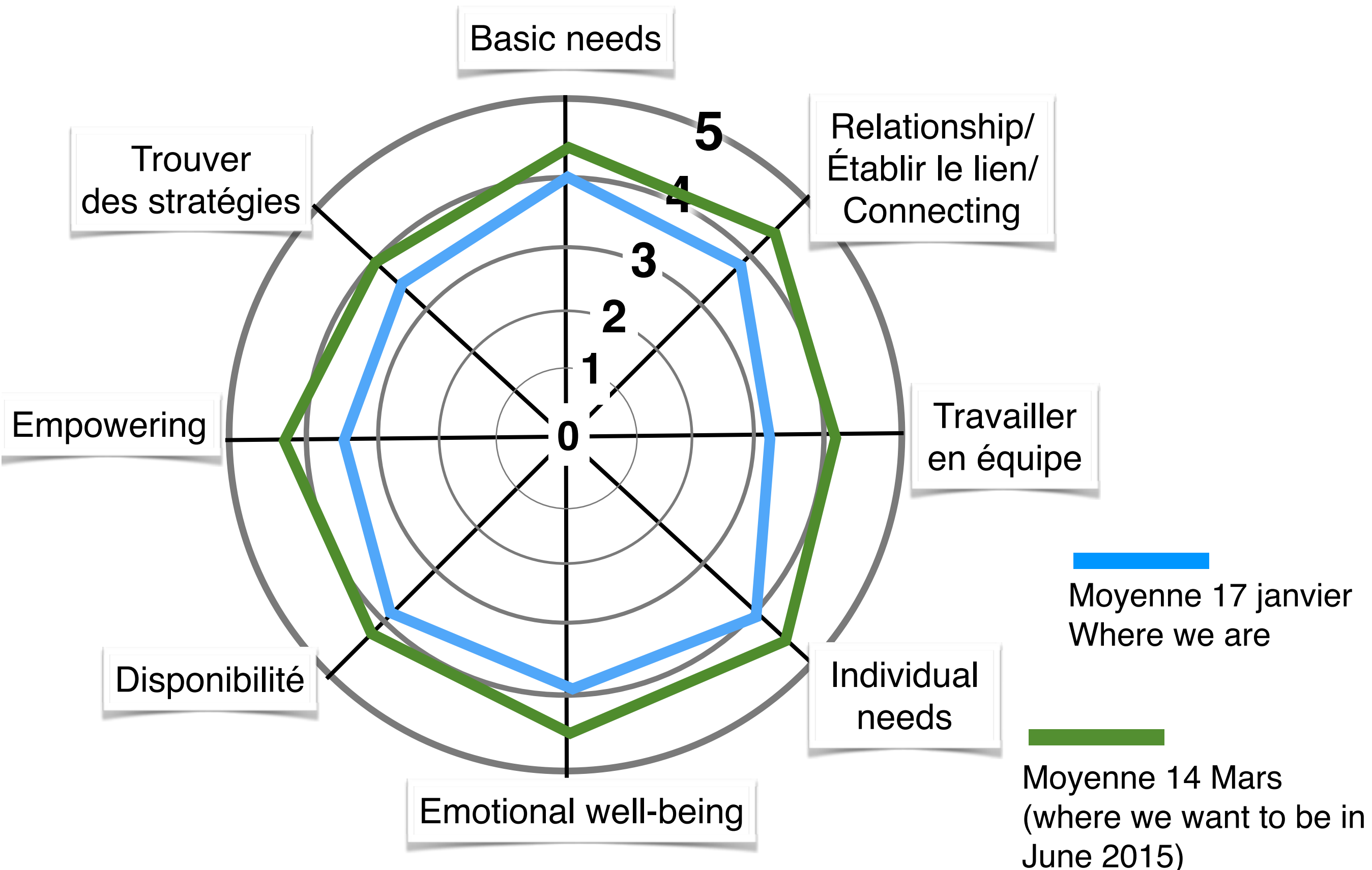


The Socratic Wheel

ePearl: The evolution of teaching approaches through the use of an electronic portfolio

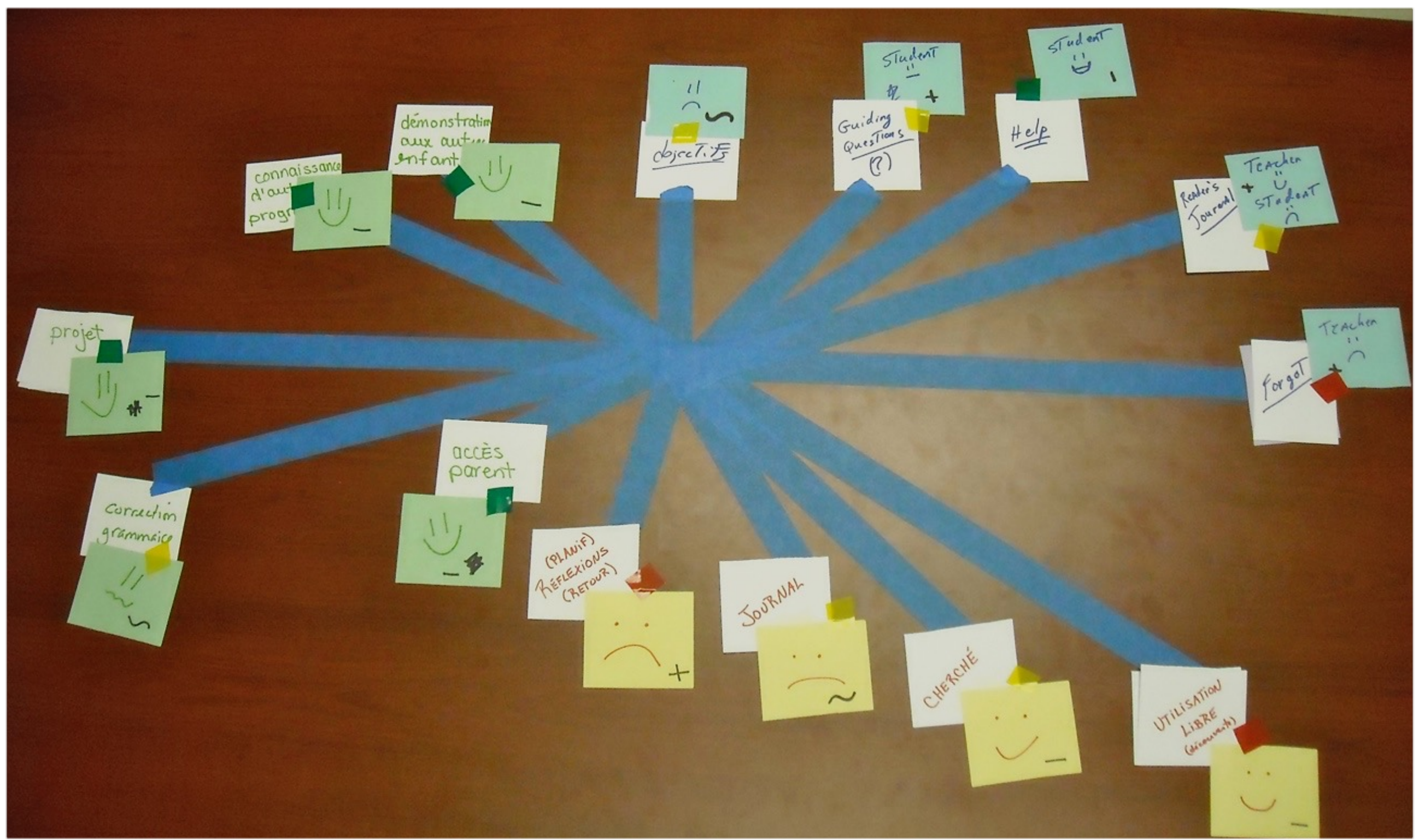
Research question:

- Can this reflective process help inform teacher education programs?

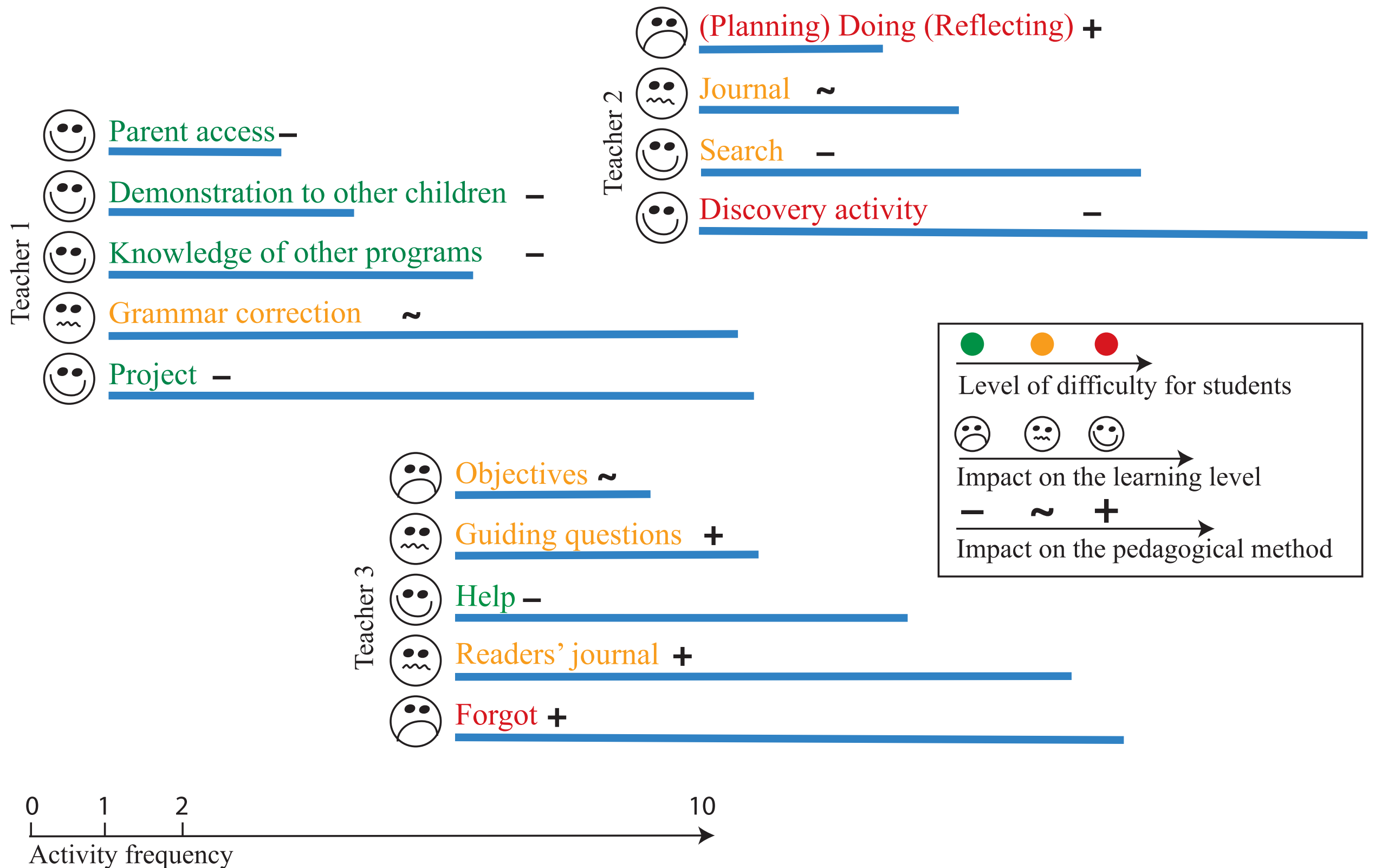
Focus group questions

- Do you think they had an impact on your pedagogical approach?



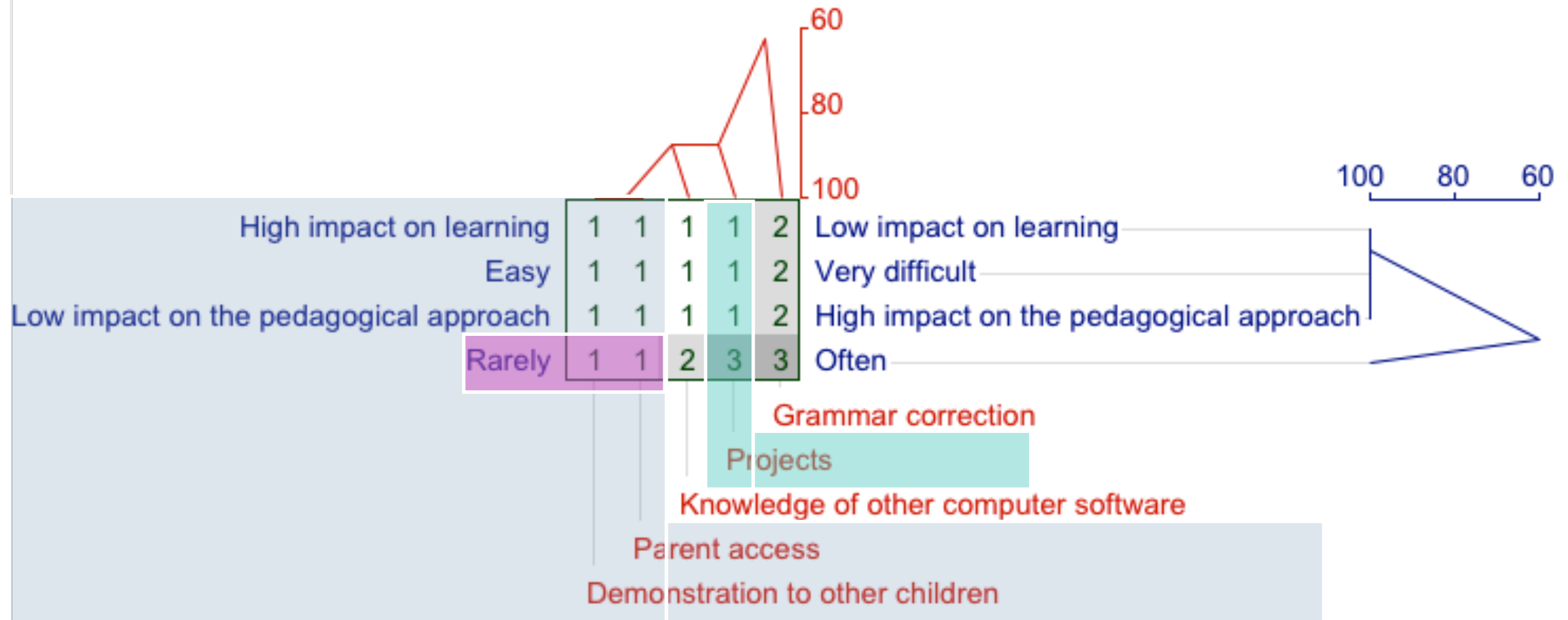
