Program Progression Requirements: A student must achieve a minimum grade of C in all professional nursing courses (NURS) in order to pass the course. Students who earn a grade lower than a C in any of the courses designated NURS will be put on program probation, regardless of their overall GPA. A second grade of less than C in any repeated NURS designated course will result in an academic standing of Program Dismissal. In addition, a second grade of less than C in any subsequent theory and practicum course (<u>NURS 1700U</u>, <u>NURS 2700U</u>, <u>NURS 2701U</u>, <u>NURS 2701U</u>, <u>NURS 2701U</u>, <u>NURS 4700U</u>, <u>NURS 4700U</u>, <u>NURS 4700U</u>, <u>NURS 4701U</u>) will result in program dismissal. Also, a total of three failures in any combination of required HLSC or NURS courses will result in an academic standing of Program Dismissal. Effective May 2023, a student who has two withdrawals from a single NURS course and/or a total of three withdrawals from a combination of required HLSC or NURS courses will be program dismissed.
